LADIES' DAY PROCEDURE

- Members must report to the pro shop 30 minutes before tee time.
- Shot-gun start times vary by month according to the calendar in your roster book.
- Please be sure to inform the pro shop of any changes in your foursome.
- If you are not signed up for a game, check with the pro shop for any cancellations or openings.
- Notify both the pro shop and a member of your foursome if you are unable to keep your starting time.
- Five-somes will not be permitted.
- Improving your lie (bumping the ball) is not allowed. If course conditions warrant, an exception for the current round will be made by the Tournament Chair on the advice of the pro shop. Notification will be by an announcement over the intercom prior to play and will be noted on your scorecard.
- If you do not have a full team for team events, keep a scorecard with appropriate "pops", and the Tournament Committee will supply a blind draw.

NOTE: There is no provision for a blind draw in Chapman, Scrambles, and Shambles.

SIGN-UP SHEETS (New procedure for 2019 season)

- Sign-up sheets will be posted in the pro shop for the following **two** play days.
- Sign up only yourself and your foursome.
- **Write in all players' names in your foursome by the completion of play on Thursdays. If you are unable to sign up by this time, email or call Judy Sather.**
- DO NOT erase anyone's name other than your own or another player in your group.
- Check to make sure that neither you nor someone in your group is signed up twice.
- **Walkers:** Please indicate with a "W" next to your name if you intend to walk.

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must supply 5 18-hole scores, dated, signed, and attested to be eligible to compete in ladies' day tournaments.
- Transfers or multi-club members only, must show proof of past records: name of club, handicap index, and GHIN number, if applicable.

USGA & LOCAL RULES

Reno Women's Golf Club Rules and Information

- Preferred Lies: May be played at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. During this time the player may improve the lie of her ball within a scorecard length and **in like conditions** through the general area.
- Lost Ball: Rule 18.1. The player is encouraged to play a provisional ball if she thinks her ball may be lost outside of a water hazard.
- Embedded ball: Rule 16
- Putting Green: Rule 13. The player may touch the line of play. What the player is allowed to repair on the green: see Rule 13.1c(2).
- Penalty areas (water hazards/lateral water hazards): Rule 17
- Out of bounds: Rule 18. Defined by all perimeter fencing on the course and white stakes and/or lines on holes 1, 9, 10, 14, and 18.
- Doubt as to procedure: Rule 20.1c(3). A player unsure of her rights or procedure may play out the hole with 2 balls. The player must declare her intention to invoke this Rule and which ball will be counted (at the time of invoking the Rule) if the Rules permit. She must report facts to the Tournament Committee before signing and returning her scorecard. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. The RWGC Tournament Committee will make the final decision.

- Yardage markers on the course are deemed to be moveable **ONLY** if the marker impedes your swing or stance, **NOT** line of sight.
- Obstructions: Rule 15 and 16. Relief is available under this Rule for all concrete walls, staked or tagged trees, all roads and cart paths on the Course, and the protective fence behind #10 green.
- Abnormal Course Conditions: Rule 16. Ground under repair is defined by white lines or stakes. It includes equipment and cart ruts, newly seeded or aerated areas in the cut of the fairway of the hole being played, ***even if not so marked.***
- Stones in bunkers: Rule 15.1 (Loose impediments) Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. If a stone or pebble impedes your swing or follow-through in the bunker, you may remove it without penalty.
- Cell phones: As a courtesy to others, please refrain from using your cell phone on the golf course.

Washoe Golf Course does not have any waste bunkers.

RENO WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB

STANDING RULES

(Revised 2019)

USGA Rules will govern all play except as modified by local rules or such temporary rules as determined by the Rules Committee and approved by the Board of Directors.

WEEKLY TOURNAMENT PLAY

1) Eligibility

a) Must have USGA handicap. To obtain this handicap, USGA requires a minimum of five 18-hole scores to be posted within the past 24 months.

Sign-up Procedure

b) See "Ladies' Day Procedure" p. 9

2) All players will play with their full handicap.

3) Awards

a) Prizes will be awarded to 1/3, or a fraction thereof, of each flight.

b) There will be a minimum of one gross and one net prize per flight.

4) Scorecards

a) Each player will have her own scorecard unless it is a team event.

b) Each player will have her score kept by another player in her foursome.

c) In the case that a player does not complete a hole, she shall record, for posting purposes, the score she **most likely** would have had that does not exceed her ESC limit. An "X" must precede that score on her card.

d) Scorecards must have legible first and last name, date, ESC adjusted score, handicap, GHIN number, and be signed by the player and attested by the marker.

IMPORTANT: Include both Gross and Net Totals.

- e) Check your hole-by-hole score with your marker to ensure that you are signing an accurate score. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- f) Signed and attested scorecards should be turned into the tournament committee **immediately** after the round. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Any player leaving the premises without turning in her completed scorecard may be disqualified.
- g) Incomplete or incorrect cards may be disqualified.

5) Breaking Ties

- a) The tournament committee will break ties according to USGA recommended method in the USGA Handicap System and Golf Committee manual.

6) Flight breakdown

- a) Flight distribution and the number of flights will be determined each week according to the handicaps of participating competitors. The maximum number of flights will be six, but may be fewer depending on the number of competitors.

7) Pace of Play

- a) Each group should keep up with the group in front of them. Allow faster groups to play through. Players are encouraged to play “ready golf” whenever possible.

8) Players must putt out in individual stroke play.

9) The use of GPS or range finders will be allowed.

10) Dress Code

- a) Please respect the game, the course, and your fellow players by wearing appropriate golf attire. No cut-offs or short-shorts, no tank tops, tube tops, halters or sports bras without a shirt worn over them.

11) Posting Scores

- a) The Handicap Committee will post all weekly tournament scores.
- b) All other adjusted gross scores obtained through play at any course during the GHIN posting season must be posted on the computer at the course or on GHIN.com
- c) If a player plays 13 or more holes for an 18-hole score or 7 or more holes for a 9-hole score, *for handicap purposes*, her score on holes not played shall be PAR plus any handicap strokes she is entitled to receive on the hole.
- d) If a player starts but does not complete a hole, she shall record, *for handicap purposes*, the score she most likely would have made if the hole had been completed, but such score shall not exceed the limit in the ESC.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1) The tournament committee shall set dates, starting times, and deadline for entries in the tournament.
- 2) The tournament will be 36 holes of flighted stroke play.
- 3) Flight breakdown will be the same as weekly tournaments.
- 4) USGA and local rules shall apply as set forth by the Rules Committee.
- 5) The player recording the lowest gross score will be Club Champion. The player recording the lowest net score will be Net Champion.
- 6) Eligibility
 - a. Player must have played a minimum of 5 rounds on RWGC play days during the current season.
 - b. Player must be a member in good standing (dues paid 60 days prior to the first day of the tournament).
 - c. Player must have an established USGA handicap; past record of 20 18-hole scores played in the last 24 months.

7) Players will play with full handicap.

8) Pairings

- a. First Day: Players will be paired according to handicap index within flights: 1, 3, 5, 7; 2, 4, 6, 8; etc.
- b. Second Day: Players will be paired according to gross score within flights: 1, 2, 3, 4; 5, 6, 7, 8: etc.

9) The use of GPS or range finders will be allowed.

10) Awards

a. Awards per flight

- i. Prizes will be awarded to (1/3), or a fraction thereof, of each flight.
- ii. Gross and net position shall be paid equally.
- iii. A player is entitled to only one prize.

b. Champion Awards

- i. The Club Champion will receive an individual award.
- ii. The Club Champion and Net Champion will receive equal prizes.

11) Ties

- a. Club Champion (gross and net) will be determined by a sudden-death play-off, starting from a designated hole.
- b. All other ties will be determined by using the USGA recommended method per the USGA Handicap System and Golf Committee Manual.

12) Scorecards will be kept as in weekly tournament play.

END OF YEAR AWARDS

Eclectic

- 1) Eclectic flights will be determined based on the current handicaps and number of players who sign up for the eclectic competition.
- 2) Players must participate in the tournament of the day for eligibility.

Most Improved Golfers

- 1) Must have USGA handicap.
- 2) Must have a past record of twenty 18-hole scores played within the last 24 months.
- 3) Must have recorded ten 18-hole rounds on RWGC play days at Washoe County Golf Course during the current season.
- 4) Awards will be divided into three handicap divisions based on your handicap at the start of the season as follows:
 - i) Handicap Division I: 0 – 23
 - ii) Handicap Division II: 24 – 32
 - iii) Handicap Division III: 33 – 40+

Hole-In-One

- 1) Any club member making a hole-in-one at Washoe County Golf Course will receive an award commemorating the event and her name will be engraved on a plaque displayed at Washoe County Golf Course.
- 2) Any club member making a hole-in-one on any accredited golf course other than Washoe County Golf Course will have her name engraved on a plaque displayed at Washoe County Golf Course.

Break Awards

- 1) Members breaking a gross score of 100, 90, or 80 for the first time will receive an award.
- 2) Score must have been recorded at Washoe County Golf Course on Ladies' Day.
- 3) Player must post her break score on the bulletin board in the Ladies' locker room.

ASSIGNMENT OF STROKES (POPS)

HDCP 01 -18	Take strokes (pops) equal to your handicap, beginning with the #1 handicap stroke hole on the scorecard.
HDCP 19 - 36	Subtract 18 from your handicap. You are allowed two strokes (pops) per hole on however many strokes left over. <u>EXAMPLE:</u> Handicap of 22: $22 - 18 = 4$. Take 2 strokes (pops) on the #1 handicap through #4 handicap holes. Take one stroke (pop) on all other holes.
HDCP 37 - +	Subtract 36 from your handicap. You are allowed three strokes (pops) per hole on however many strokes left over (calculated and distributed on holes as described above). Take two strokes (pops) on all other holes.

To determine your net score on a hole, subtract the “pops” from your gross score for that hole. **EXAMPLE:** You take an 8 on the #1 handicap hole and you are entitled to 3 pops, therefore your net score for that hole will be 5.

EQUITABLE STROKE CONTROL (ESC)

The following sets out the maximum strokes a player can post on any hole, whether a 3, 4, or 5 par, depending on the Player’s course handicap.

Course Handicap	Maximum Score Posted on any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 and above	10

Remember the “Rule of Sixes”
when determining your maximum ESC score –
add 6 to the first digit of your Course Handicap, e.g.,
a player with a 22 Course Handicap can only take an 8 (2 + 6);
a player with a 35 Course Handicap can only take a 9 (3 + 6).

HIGH SIERRA TEAM PLAY INFORMATION

- 1) Sign-up sheets will be posted every month to qualify for Team Play. Maximum handicap for Team Play is 36. Handicaps over 36 will be reduced to 36.
- 2) Qualifying days vary. Check the calendar in the roster book.
- 3) Team members are determined by the three lowest gross and 3 lowest net scores recorded on qualifying days. All players must qualify and compete to a maximum of 36 handicap.
- 4) Teams of six members will compete with other teams of six members at six different golf courses for six months. See schedule below.
- 5) **FORMAT:** Team match play. Each club will have 6 players forming 3 2-player teams. Each 2-player team will play better ball against another club's 2-player team. 18 holes will be completed, equaling a total of 18 points.
- 6) The club with the most points accumulated over the six tournaments wins.
- 7) If you belong to more than one club, you may represent only one club in team play for the season.

Birdies for Washoe

Proceeds benefit the Washoe Junior Golf Program. Voluntary one-time \$10 buy-in. Five tournament days are played in conjunction with regular RWGC play days. Claudia O'Mera will keep track of participants' birdies, eagles, net birdies, and net eagles for the five tournament days. At the conclusion of the tournament, each participant will be asked to donate \$1 for each birdie, eagle, net birdie and net eagle scored on the tournament days. Dates: 5/9, 5/23, 5/30, 6/13, 6/20.

PACE OF PLAY

- No one likes to play with or follow a slow player. Be ready and prepared when it's your turn to hit.
- Please help your group be aware if your group falls behind.
- Keep up with the group in front of you. If you are unable to keep up, please allow the group behind you to play through.
- Keep any pre-shot practice short.
- Finish conversations after your shot.
- Use the carts efficiently so as not to waste time to get to each player's shot.
- Continuous putting is encouraged. Two players may leave the green if play is completed and get ready to tee off at the next hole.
- If in doubt on a ruling, play another ball and keep track of both balls for that hole, and check on the correct ruling when turning in your scorecard.

TOURNAMENT FORMATS

2-GAL BEST BALL

Stroke play. Record the lowest GROSS and the lowest NET score per hole.

2-GAL 6-6-6

(*No provision is made for a blind draw. See pro shop for a partner.)
Holes 1-6: Scramble. Holes 7-12: Best Ball. Holes 13 -18: Alternate Shot.

2-GAL PRO AM

A Pro will be designated for you. Your team consists of a Pro and two players. Record all three player's scores. Bring down & total the 2 lowest best ball gross & net per hole. You may use same balls to record GROSS and NET scores. You do not have to use Pro's score.

2-GAL SCRAMBLE

Both players will tee off. Pick best drive. Both will play from within one club length from that ball, no closer to the hole. Continue in the same manner until ball is holed out. Subtract ½ of partners' combined handicaps for net score.

2-GAL SCRAMBLE 3 CLUBS AND A PUTTER (*No provision is made for a blind draw. See pro shop for a partner.)

Select the three clubs you will be using prior to the round and include ONLY them and your putter in your bag. Clubs MAY NOT be shared between partners.

Both players will tee off. Pick best drive. Both will play from within one club length from that ball, no closer to the hole. Continue in the same manner until ball is holed out. Subtract ½ of partners' combined handicaps for net score.

4-GAL DEVIL BALL

On each hole, one player's ball is designated the "Devil Ball". Players will rotate as the Devil Ball player: Player A on hole 1, B on hole 2, C on hole 3, D on hole four, etc. Two scores are added together on each hole for the team score: the NET score of the golfer playing the Devil Ball and the best NET ball among the other three golfers on the team.

4-GAL CHA CHA CHA

Use 1 best ball on 1st hole, 2 best balls on 2nd hole, 3 best balls on 3rd hole. Repeat procedure through 18 holes. Total the score of best balls, with allocated pops, for NET score.

4-GAL HIT & SIT

All players tee off. Choose the best drive. The player whose drive is chosen sits out the next shot. The three other players play from within one club length of the drive. Continue the same way onto the green. Putt from within 6" of that spot until the ball is holed out. With the exception of the drive, one player will always be sitting out on each shot. 1/4 of the players' combined handicap will be used to calculate net score.

AWESOME "3" SOME

Select the best three Par 3 holes, best three Par 4 holes, best three Par 5 holes. Total these holes and subtract 1/2 of your handicap.

ONES

Stroke play. Total score for holes beginning with the letters "O, N, E, and S" (1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 16, 17, 18). Subtract 1/2 handicap for net score.

PAR FOURS

Stroke play. Total score on all par 4 holes (1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 13, 17). Subtract 1/2 handicap for net score.

RENO POINTS

Each player is given a point quota based on her handicap. (46 minus handicap = quota). Total your points then subtract your point quota. Prizes are awarded for the most points over each player's quota.

STROKE PLAY & PUTTS

Total gross score and subtract handicap for net score. Keep putts if part of the tournament that days. Only putts made on the green count.

T's & F's

Stroke Play. Keep gross score for posting purposes. Tournament score will be used for holes which start with "T" and "F" (2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15). One-half handicap will be used to calculate net score.


THROW OUT THREE

Stroke Play. After completing 18 holes, throw out your three worst **gross** scores. Add the gross scores for the remaining 15 holes for your total gross score. Subtract the pops on the three holes that were thrown out from your handicap on the card. Subtract the remaining handicap from your gross score on the 15 holes to get your net score
