WASHOE MONSTER GOLF

*Men: WHITE TEES and Women: RED TEES (unless otherwise noted)

*Lift, Clean and Place any ball in fairway or bunkers

*Hybrids are considered a wood or an iron, your choice.

*Handicap (if applicable): 50%

Hole 1: Woods ONLY – Best Ball (*Can use putter once on green*)

Hole 2: Tees on back of tee box– Shamble Format (see definition below)-Best Ball

Hole 3: 8 Inch Cup – Best Ball

Hole 4: All Players play from forward red tee (300 yards) – Best Ball

Hole 5: Play with 1 club of choice for entire hole – Best Ball (*can use putter once on green*)

Hole 6: Must putt with your driver – Best Ball

Hole 7: Every player must kick their ball once without penalty – Best Ball

Hole 8: Take half of the best score (round up, if nec.) – Best Ball

Hole 9: Play back tee (by creek). Move ball 1 club CLOSER on each shot – Best Ball

Hole 10: Irons ONLY – Best Ball (*Can use putter once on green*)

Hole 11: Tee from mat on top of hill – Best Ball

Hole 12: Every player must throw or toss once without penalty – Best Ball

Hole 13: Both partners hit, take worst shot. Repeat until holed – One Score

Hole 14: Scramble – One Score

Hole 15: Alternate Shot-One Score

Hole 16: Play forward tees. Add both scores together – One Score

Hole 17: Chapman Scotch (see definition below) – One Score

Hole 18: No flag on 18 Good Luck :-) Scramble—One Score

Best Ball—Both players play their own ball throughout the hole

Shamble— Both players drive, take best drive, play individual ball out until holed

Scramble—Both players hit, take best shot, repeat same process until holed

Chapman Scotch—Both Players tee off, players switch tee shots and hit second shot. From that point you choose the best shot and alternate until ball is holed.
