- 1. USGA rules will apply except where local rules prevail.
- 2. Out of Bounds:
 - · Golf course property line fences
 - · White line behind 9 & 18 greens
 - Parking lot to the right of No. 10 tee
 - · Putting green
- 3. Flags indicate location of holes:
 - Red-front of green
 - · White-middle of green
 - Blue-back of green
- 4. Unplayable lie is one stroke penalty.
- 5. Water hazards: No. 3 & 8.
- 6. Lateral waters: All other lakes and irrigation ditches.
- Lost ball-drop as near as possible to point where ball was lost - one stroke penalty.
- 8. Drop one club length from all marked or staked trees.
- 9. Proper attire required, including shirts and shoes.
- 10. Keep carts on paths, 90° rule in effect.
- Golfers are responsible for property damage and bodily injury caused by their golf shots.
 - Repair ball marks on greens
 Replace divots
 - Rake bunkers Leave rakes in bunkers
